We have already experienced a very busy and extremely fruitful 2010, and the year is only half over. Saturday, we leave for our five-week evangelistic mission project in the Philippines, where more than 100 Americans will participate. This year, we are targeting the Islands of Marinduque, Romblon, and Cebu, five provinces on the main Island of Luzon, and three provinces on the Southern Island of Mindanao. Please keep our summer missionaries and our Filipino staff in your prayers.

I recently returned from a great trip to two unnamed countries in Asia, one predominately Hindu and one predominately Muslim. For some time now, BTEA has had a presence in these two countries, where we are engaged in evangelism, church planting, training believers, orphanages, and rescuing girls from human trafficking. In one country, I was able to enjoy the graduation of 14 of our Bible school students from the school we help support. I also had the privilege of spending time with eight of the 15 girls we have rescued from the sex slave industry during the past two years. The transformation that Christ has made in these precious girls since their rescue is absolutely incredible! In the other unnamed country, we held evangelistic meetings in a number of villages and were able to preach to 250 plus people and see 53 Muslims put their faith in Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of sins and the free gift of eternal life.

In April, a 40-foot-long container, shipped by *America's Heart*, arrived at the port near our orphanage, Uncle Dick's Home. The container included much needed medical supplies, equipment, food, medicine and more. We were able to share the contents with a number of medical clinics and hospitals in the area where we work on a regular basis. A defibrillator and dialysis machine were donated to the hospital in Surallah, where our orphans receive medical care. The medical personnel in all of the facilities were elated because of the life-saving opportunities the new equipment provides their patients.

Our national Filipino staff is now up to 50 men, who are doing a tremendous job. This year, we are averaging over 800 film showings a month, with an average monthly attendance of over 140,000. As a result, more than 100,000 people have publicly responded to the gospel by indicating their decision to trust Jesus Christ for the free gift of eternal life. We are so thankful that God is blessing our evangelistic efforts in the Philippines during one of the truly great harvest times in history!

Pam had hip replacement surgery on June 4. Please pray that she would make steady, constant progress in her efforts to walk unaided before her busy speaking schedule resumes.

We do not take for granted the generosity and the prayer support of all those who invest in souls through BTEA. Although our 2010 ministry results are up, our income is down; yet, we trust God to direct our paths, as He has done for the past 25 years.
